



### SF Pathways to Citizenship Workshop

Over 500 eligible legal permanent residents attended

The "Mega" Naturalization Workshop that took place on February 27th at the Bill Graham Civic Auditorium, organized by the San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Initiative, was a success with over 500 eligible legal permanent residents receiving services provided by 500 volunteers. The event was attended by elected officials including Mayor of San Francisco Edwin M. Lee, Assessor-Recorder Carmen Chu and Supervisor Eric Mar.

San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship is a collaborative initiative that provides free bi-monthly naturalization workshops. Legal permanent residents who are qualified for citizenship can receive assistance with a step-by-step review of naturalization processes, application preparation, documentation, attorney consultation, packaging and application review by an immigration lawyer or qualified representative.

This is the third year of operation for

the San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Initiative. We have had an extremely successful three years, with over 4,500 citizenship applications being completed and about 9,000 residents served. The next Naturalization Workshop is scheduled for Saturday, April 23rd, 2016 from 9:30 am - 12:30 pm at City College Chinatown/North Beach Campus, 808 Kearny Street, San Francisco CA 94108.

# 超過五百位合資格的永久居民參加三藩市公民入籍計劃工作坊

由三藩市公民道路計劃組織(San Francisco Pathway to Citizenship Initiative)舉辦本年度最大型的《免費公民入籍工作坊》於二月二十七日在 Bill Graham Civic Auditorium 成功舉行。當日五百多名義工為超過五百位合資格的永久居民提供免費入籍填表和咨詢的服務。現任三藩市市長李孟賢,估值官朱嘉文,以及市參事馬兆光亦有到場支持該活動。

三藩市公民道路計劃是由多個組織協辦。工作坊為符合資格的永久居民提供每兩個月一次免費公民入籍的工作坊。服務包括有詳細地檢閱申請人的入籍資格,協助申請人填寫入籍申請表,最後並由移民律師或合資格法務代表審閱整份已準備完整的申請表。今年六月尾便是三藩市公民道路計劃成立的三週年。過去三年,此計劃成功協助完成超過四千五百份申請表,為超過九千位永久居民提供入籍服務。我們下一個免費入籍工作坊將於二零一六年四月二十三日早上九時三十分至中午十二時三十分在三藩市市立大學,干尼街八零八號舉行。

三藩市公民道路計劃由七個社區機構組成,包括安老自助處、天主教慈善機構、La Raza 社區資源中心、猶太家庭及兒童服務中心、灣區國際機構、亞洲法律聯會、以及亞太裔法律外展機構。此計劃由多個機構資助,包括三藩市縣公民及移民事務辦公室 (OCEIA) , San Francisco Foundation, Gerbode Foundation, Asian Pacific Fund, Evelyn and Walter Haas, Jr. Fund, Walter and Elise Haas Fund 及 Grantmakers Concerned with Immigrants and Refugees。

### Seismic Safety Outreach Program Graduation

On March 18th, 103 happy graduates gathered together at Northern California Presbyterian Homes & Services East Park Apartments to celebrate the Seismic Safety Outreach Program Graduation. Mr. Tom Hui, Director of the Department of Building Inspection (DBI), was an honorable guest. At the ceremony, Director Hui congratulated the graduates and presented each individual a certificate and emergency survival kit. The kit contains essential items like emergency food bars, drinking water packets, 12-hour light stick, emergency survival blanket and tissue.

During the commencement speech, Director Hui stressed the importance of the Seismic Safety Outreach Program to the community. The knowledge gained from this program enables the partakers to care for themselves and people around them especially during the first 72 hours after a disaster. Mr. Hui thus encouraged the participants to share the information with their friends and families and reminded the audience to keep the emergency survival kits near their beds for easy access when responding to an emergency. Furthermore, Director Hui expressed DBI's initiative to continue the program with available funding. Ms. Anni Chung, President and CEO of Self-Help for the Elderly, thanked Mr. Hui for his ongoing support of Self-Help and DBI's commitment to the multi-cultural senior community.

Launched in mid-July 2015, the Seismic Safety Outreach Program provided ten free of charge workshops in both English and Chinese to the Chinatown community that included hands-on training and education on emergency preparedness, fire safety and post-disaster response.

Mr. Rong Zhi Yu and Ms. Jing Mei Zhou were two graduates present at the event and were happy to share tips they learned at the workshops. Mr. Yu pointed out the importance of confirming the safety of the surrounding area before exiting the building. Ms. Zhou was appreciative to receive basic first aid and CPR trainings. The graduation ceremony concluded with a group photo and lunch.

防地震安全推廣計劃課程是在二零一五年七月中推 出,提供十個免費的雙語(英語及中文)班。課程包 括實踐訓練、應急準備常識、消防安全及災難後的應 變措施等。

### Custodial Training Graduate Continues to Work at California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC)

Xiangxian Xiong immigrated to the United States in 2011. She was interested in working in the Custodial industry; unfortunately she did not have any formal training and experience to be a competitive candidate in applying for jobs in this field. On January 4, 2014, Xiangxian Xiong enrolled in our custodial training and graduated three months later. During the custodial training, Xiangxian Xiong gained invaluable occupational and job readiness skills.

With the assistance of her Career Advisor at the Chinatown Neighborhood Access Point (formerly One Stop Career Center), Xiangxian Xiong received assistance with our job search, resume and cover letter, and interview preparation. With thorough training and preparation, Xiangxian Xiong was successfully offered a part-time job on April 21, 2014 as Housekeeping Aide for California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC). A little over a year later, Xiangxian Xiong was promoted to a full-time Housekeeping Aide.

Xiangxian Xiong shared with us that Chinatown Neighborhood Access Point's occupational training and the assistance of her Career Advisor were instrumental in helping her gain employment in her interested field of work, as well as helping her earn a good salary to support her family and life in the United States.

Our Custodial training program is operated in partnership with City College of San Francisco (CCSF). CCSF provides the occupational skills training while Self-Help for the Elderly offers the job preparation and placement services. This training is made possible with funding from the San Francisco Office of Economic & Workforce Development and the San Francisco Foundation.

在二零一一年熊香嫻移民到美國。她希望在清潔行業發展,可是她沒有接受過專業培訓或擁有相關的工作經驗,所以較難在這行業與其他求職者競爭。在二零一四年一月十四日,熊女士參加本中心舉辦的清潔課程,並於三個月後畢業。在培訓期間熊女士不但獲得實貴的培訓經驗,而且學到一門就業準備技巧。

在華埠一站式就業中心熊女士得到職業顧問協助搜尋工作、書寫個人履簡歷、求職信及面試準備等指導。 再加上參加了為期三個月的清潔培訓計劃,在二零一四年四月二十一日加州太平洋醫療中心聘請熊女士為一名兼職家務助理。一年後因工作表現優良,熊女士被轉為全職。

熊女士跟我們分享她在華埠一站式就業中心所得到的 職業培訓及職業顧問的協助,令她在清潔業取得更多 的工作機會,也獲得更好的工資,從而使她與家人的 生活過得更好。

本中心的清潔培訓計劃是與三藩市城市大學合辦。三 藩市城市大學負責提供職業培訓,而安老自助處則給 予就業準備和職業介紹的服務。這個培訓計劃由三藩 市經濟及勞動發展局和三藩市基金會支助。



# Happy Client Praises HICAP San Mateo

Through HICAP of San Mateo, a former civil servant in Hong Kong learned the definition of public service and compassion at a time of distress in his adopted country.

Mr. Tam was in a state of panic when he learned he did not have creditable medical insurance after his employer closed down his business recently. He had been enrolled in Medicare Part A and was part of an employer group health plan (EGHP).

A 15-year resident of San Mateo County, Mr. Tam was insured under Covered California. Knowing the business was about to close, Mr. Tam thought he could continue coverage by paying on his own. He had a rude awakening when he applied for Part B upon termination of his EGHP, thinking he was now in a qualifying event that triggers what Medicare calls Special Enrollment Period (SEP). Mr. Tam did not know it then but his EGHP was specifically for small businesses.

Based on incorrect information, the clerk Social Security clerk told Mr. Tam he had to wait until Medicare General Enrollment Period. In that case, he would not have coverage for several months!

"I'm very healthy, but I'm at an age when I should be realistic and be prepared," said the 69-year-old Mr. Tam, who was born on U.S. Independence Day. Mr. Tam sought help from friends, who suggested that he call HICAP or Health Insurance Counseling and Advocacy Program to sign up for Medicare Part B, which covers outpatient and home health care, durable medical equipment and some preventive services.

The worried Mr. Tam aired his apprehensions to his daughter Miss Tam who then called HICAP of San Mateo, explained her father's situation and asked for an appointment with a Cantonese-speaking counselor. Mr. Tam met with John Leung, a HICAP counselor based at the San Mateo Senior Center.

John presented the situation to the Program Manager, Christina Kahn, who concurred with his assessment: Mr. Tam's previous EGHP was Covered California for Small Business and its termination was a qualifying event giving him SEP and allowing him to enroll in Part B. After initially being denied, Mr. Tam was finally able to get Kaiser Medicare coverage, but not without help from the HICAP Counselor. "Our reputation helped get us over the speed bumps", explained John.

Mr. Tam expressed his relief and gratitude and praised the effort and work done by Christina and John of HICAP San Mateo. "HICAP knows how to help people", said Mr. Tam.

### 快樂客戶讚譽聖馬刁的醫療保險 顧問及促進權益計劃 - HICAP

來到一個新的環境下,透過聖馬刁的醫療保險顧問及促進權益計劃-HICAP服務,一位前香港公務員在困難的時刻體會到公共服務和親切的重要意義。

譚生參加了「聯邦醫療保險A部份」的計劃及雇主所屬的顧主團体醫療保險 - EGHP。當雇主公司接近倒閉時而明日自己將沒有可信的醫療保險時,譚生感到十分恐慌。

有聖馬刁縣居住了十五年的譚先生,是透過在南三藩市器械經銷商和服務中心的工作而參加加州投保- Cover California醫療保險。他知道雇主即將關閉業務,以為可以通過自付保險費而繼續參加 「加州投保」醫療保險。譚生很惊愕地發現自己將有幾個月沒有醫療保險。原因是在终止雇主所屬的顧主團体醫療保險所稱的特別登記時段(SEP),於是他便申請聯邦醫療保險計劃是專為小型企業而設。基於不正確的資料,社會安全福利人員告訴譚生他要等到下一期聯邦醫療保險計劃申請期間。因此,譚生將有幾個月沒有醫療保險。

「我一向是很健康的,但到我這個年紀,我應該要準備及實際一點,」這位在美國獨立日出生的六十九歲的譚先生曰。譚先生向朋友尋求幫助,朋友建議他聯絡醫療保險顧問及促進權益計劃報名參加而聯邦醫療保險 B 部份醫療保險計劃,該計劃包括門診和家庭醫療保健,實用醫療設備和一些預防性服務護理。

不安的譚先生與女兒聯絡,譚小姐致電聖馬刁醫療保險顧問及促進權益計劃,解釋了她父親的情況,並要求預見說粵語的顧問。譚生與聖馬刁中心醫療保險顧問及促進權益計劃顧問 John Leung (梁生) 會面。

梁生是該計劃中的三十位國家註冊顧問之一。項目經理 Christina Kahn 同意梁生的評估。事實上,如果譚生之前的EGHP醫療保險計劃是小型企業的 Covered California 的話,在終止醫療保險計劃時,譚生是合乎資格獲得 SEP,並讓他申報B部分。經過首輪被拒後,但得到醫療保險顧問的幫助下, 譚先生最終能得到Kaiser醫療保險。「我們在社區的良好聲譽幫助我們遞速達成譚生的個案。」梁生說。

鬆了一口氣的譚生十分感謝及讚場醫療保險顧問梁生和 Christina,他表示,「醫療保險顧問及促進權益計劃熟識多種醫療保險計劃及法案,知道如何幫助他人。」
