

Custodial Training Student – Mr. Lin

Mr. Lin was a December 2015 Graduate from the 4th cohort custodial training offered by Self-Help for the Elderly (SHE) in partnership with City College of San Francisco. Previously, he had been earning the minimum wage as a waiter at a Chinese restaurant for over 15 years since he moved to the United States. Mr. Lin saw no room in career growth due to his limited English proficiency. He, therefore, decided to switch his career path in hopes to expand job opportunities. He enrolled in the custodial training provided by SHE. Mr. Lin studied hard and maintained a good relationship with the custodial training instructors. The custodial training strengthened his skills and broadened the career opportunities. He actively visited Chinatown Neighborhood Access Point (CNAP). There, Mr. Lin met with the career advisor to develop his employment plan and to improve the soft skills on interview. When he was ready, Mr. Lin was connected with California Pacific Medical Center (CPMC) through a prescreening event at CNAP. Mr. Lin also received assistance from his career advisor on filling out job application, resume editing, and interview preparation for the housekeeping aide position. Mr. Lin was hired as the CPMC housekeeping aide in January 2016, one month after his custodial training graduation.

Mr. Lin is very happy about the career change. Furthermore, he is glad to be able to afford his son's college tuition with his current wage.

商務清潔班的畢業學員 一林先生

林先生是安老自助處華埠一站式就業中心二零一五年底第四期商務清潔班的畢業學員,林先生自移民來美後,在華埠任職侍應生已達十五年, 並一直獲取最低工資, 他發覺 若沒有更強的英語能力或其他生活技能,這個職位是沒有晉升機會的。所以,他決定參加本中心提供的商業清潔班,嘗試轉換工作,成為商務清潔人員,以尋求更多就業機會。林先生在課堂上十分勤奮,亦與導師建立良好關係,在畢業後,生活技能的缺乏已不能成為他轉工的障礙,他積極地與就業顧問聯絡,並學習如何改善他的面試技巧,就業顧問稍後介紹他參加加州太平洋醫療中心 (California Pacific Medical Center)的招聘會,他對於當中清潔服務員的職位非常感興趣,在經過填寫申請表,改寫簡歷及面試後,他於畢業後三個月後開始工作。

林先生非常開心,尤其能夠供兒子大學學費而感到欣慰。

at Adult Day Services

On August 16, 2016, Wesley Chu, Public Safety Coordinator of San Francisco Safety Awareness for Everyone (SAFE), provided a safety training for our seniors to teach them how to protect themselves from becoming a victim of blessing scams. San Francisco SAFE, Inc. is a nonprofit community crime prevention and public safety program that works closely with the San Francisco Police Department to provide safety information to the public.

Blessing scams have returned to the Bay Area and has been incredibly active in Chinese-American communities, most recently targeting two seniors in the Richmond District of San Francisco. The stories are usually synonymous, with victims being approached on the street and convinced by scammers that a member of their family may be possessed by evil spirits. The scammer then urges the victim to hand over his or her valuables to be purified in order to ward off the spirits. Valuables are then switched with scammers nowhere to be found. Chu reminded our seniors to be constantly aware of their surroundings and call 9-1-1 if they are approached by strangers offering to perform blessing ceremonies for them. Courtesy of San Francisco SAFE, all of our seniors were given a whistle and a blue tote bag, printed with "Beware of Street Scams" to spread the message.

祈福黨又再重現灣區,並活躍於美裔華人社區。最近的兩個目標 人士都是在三藩市列治民區, 受害人的故事均相同, 都是在街上 遇上騙徒遊說他們家中成員被邪靈附體,然後催促受害人交出 他/她們的貴重物品用作驅邪,騙徒取去貴重物品後,途之夭夭。

朱先生提醒長者們要對周圍環境經常提高警覺, 遇上陌生人主 動前來為自己進行祈福的儀式時, 請立刻打9-1-1報警, 三藩市 防止罪案資源中心送上一個哨子及印有「提防詐騙」的布袋給我 們的長者,好讓資訊傳播。

Celebrate National Citizenship Day

In honor of the National Citizenship Day, SF Pathways to Citizenship, local elected officials, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) and naturalized citizens gathered at Portsmouth Square Club on September 16th, to announce the launch of a new partnership program with Mission Asset Fund (MAF) intended to help more low-income residents become citizens at 50% the cost.

It is expensive to become a citizen. The fee is \$680 which adds up when a whole family applies together. Hence, the new initiative makes it easier for eligible San Francisco immigrants overcome the financial barriers to applying for citizenship.

SF Pathways to Citizenship is an initiative of the City and County of San Francisco's OCEIA. Self-Help for the Elderly is the lead agency and works with five other community based service providers selected to participate in this unique partnership with the City and County of San Francisco to offer free, quality and accessible services for those seeking information on becoming US citizens. This Initiative is also supported by San Francisco Foundation, Haas Jr. Fund and Asian Pacific Fund this year.
