San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Workshop

The first 2017 San Francisco Pathways to Citizenship Workshop doubled the typical workshop turnout. Held on February 4, the workshop would not have been successful without the tremendous support of Microsoft Corporation and the 204 volunteers who contributed their time, expertise and talents at different stations of the workshops: Registration; Filling Application; Attorney Advice; Reviewing of Application; and Mailing.

Over 400 individuals were registered and more than 350 received screenings and started their citizenship applications. Events like the SF Pathways to Citizenship Workshop are essential, particularly during the current challenging time for immigrants. The SF Pathways to Citizenship Initiative is unique and impactful as it provides free, high-quality legal services through culturally and linguistically competent information and appreciation. This is evidenced by the turnout at February's event: the vast majority of the applicants were low income and from minority community.

The Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Center (ADCRC) is one of the programs at Jackie Chan's Adult Day Services Center. Specially tailored for participants with Alzheimer's disease or other dementias, the center provides quality day care and attentive care to the participants while giving respite to their caregivers. We are currently providing daily services to approximately 17 participants with disability and/or diagnosed dementia.

In addition to providing meals and basic care, our staff will continuously design a variety of new and interesting activities to help stimulate the participants' brain and to maintain current levels of cognitive functioning. We will continue to add engaging, effective activities to promote participants' interest and participation.

Services are planned based on each individual's interest and competency. We provide collective and individual activities to enable participants to be fully integrated through visual, audio and physical experiences. The program cares for the partakers who are entrusted to us and empowers their interactions and social skills. The positive effort taken and the smile on every participant's face become our motivation and reward.
