March 12 - 20

Invitation in the mail asking you to respond online to the 2020 Census.

March 26 - April 3

A reminder poster in the mail.

April 8 - 16

English paper questionnaire in the mail.

May 28 - August 14

Census workers will visit homes that have not responded to the 2020 Census to help make sure everyone is counted.



March 9

Census 2020 telephone lines open.

March 16 - 24

A reminder letter in the mail.

April 1

Census Day.

April 20 - 27

A final reminder postcard before the U.S. Census Bureau sends someone to your house.

August 14

Census questionnaire is available online and by phone call until August 14.

2020 Census Questionnaire Guide

What to expect in the invitation:

- Letter invitation with the 12-digit "Census ID #" will be mailed to every household
- Invitation is in English
- Includes "Language Assistance" sheet (Information on phone lines in difference languages)

You do not need the invitation or Census ID # to complete the Census.

List of questions that are on the 2020 Census Questionnaire:

- Number of people in the household
- If the home is owned or rented
- Telephone number (for household)
- Each person's name, sex, age, birthdate, and race/ethnicity
- Whether the person usually lives at that home
- Relationship of each residents to the head of household

The Census will not ask about citizenship status or for any financial information.
