#### Self-Help for the Elderly Launches 2020 Census Campaign To Reach the Hard-To-Count Community

Self-Help for the Elderly (SHE) is honored to take on an active role in creating awareness and encouraging participation in the 2020 Census among the hard-to-count communities. On November 15, 2019, SHE kicked off its 2020 Census Outreach Campaign at the Lady Shaw Activity Center Press Event. This project has been made possible in part by the grants from Office of Civic Engagement & Immigrant Affairs and Silicon Valley Community Foundation. This 18-month Census 2020 Outreach program consists of conducting grassroots outreach and operating of the four Questionnaire

Assistance Centers to effectively reach, educate, and assist the most vulnerable hard-to-count populations residing in San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, and Alameda Counties.





Beginning November 15, 2019 till December 2020, SHE will integrate the outreach and education campaign components into all of its current programs and services for the vulnerable population of immigrants, seniors, and monolingual or limited English proficient individuals from different counties.

The outreach and education campaign components are as follow:

Four Questionnaire Assistance Centers (QACs) SHE facilitates four QACs in four (4) Bay Area Counties: San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, and Alameda. All QACs are equipped with public desktops or tablets for visitors to complete the Census Questionnaire as individuals or households. In addition, SHE staffs are available to assist individuals with site navigation and completion of the questions. Furthermore, SHE will host one-on-one education workshops to provide technical assistance for individuals who have their own digital devices.

#### 安老自助處展開二零二零人 口普查外展項目連繫難以統 計社區

美國政府每十年會透過人口普查統計確認在美國居住的每一個人。不過,有些社區有特別的《難以統計人口》,即是在這些社區當中,很多人可能不會或不知道對人口普查統計活動

作出回覆,這導致人口普查中出現不合比例的人口低估,即人口普查記錄的人數少於實際的社區居民人數。《難以統計人口》包括少數民族和少數族裔、租客、英語水平有限者、移民和兒童。通過不同機構的支持,安老自助處會將於二零一九年秋季至二零二零年末通過進行人口普查社區實地外展活動,提高大家對人口普查的認識,並在灣區開設四個人口普查協助中心為居住在的三藩市,聖馬刁,聖塔克拉拉和阿拉米達縣的社區成員解答人口普查問題和幫助他們提交人口普查表。

#### Self-Help for the Elderly Participated in 2019 Reimagine End of Life Week

Reimagine End of Life Week San Francisco Bay Area began on October 24 and concluded on November 3. The ten-day occasion enabled participants to have the opportunities to celebrate life and consider the final decisions. There were 250 events in the San Francisco Bay Area this year. Self-Help for the Elderly (SHE) was thrilled to return and hosted an interactive workshop Preparing Seniors for Advance Medical Directives, informing the community about the California Advance Health Care Directives form and having an opening discussion on the topics of health, healthcare options and final decisions.

SHE was excited to welcome Dr. Anita Ho, an international scholar specializing in bioethics and public health ethics, as the guest speaker. Dr. Ho shared personal stories and experiences in Cantonese while explaining to the audience the content and importance of the California Advance Health Care Directives. Later on, the Social Services staff at SHE engaged with the workshop participants via Chinese American Coalition for Compassionate Care's Heart to Heart® Café, an interactive activity designed to enable a family member, a caregiver, or a health provider to understand what a loved one's wishes when life is ending or when the individual is threatened by injury or disease.

SHE organized this unique workshop in the hopes of empowering the participants to reimagine the meaning of life through dialogue and interaction; to foster an encouraging approach in end of life planning; and to embrace life to the very end.

The guests were enthusiastic about the event and the topic. For the second consecutive year, the workshop attracted about a hundred participants.

The event kicked off with the greetings from our city's new DA Suzy Loftus. DA Loftus pledged to work closely with the law enforcement to preserve safety in the City and neighborhoods like Chinatown. Sergeant Colbert Chu of the San Francisco Police Department's (SFPD) Central Station informed the audience that there are certified Cantonese speaking officers stationed at Central Station to assist and serve the Chinatown community. Additionally, the SFPD officers are available at the Portsmouth Square Clubhouse every Wednesday and Friday from 4:30 – 8 pm. The SFPD officers welcomed the community to meet them and share their concerns. Victor Lim, with San Francisco Department of Emergency Management shared with everyone information in Chinese on safety and emergency workshops. Lastly, a community leader and advocate Esther Leung with API Legal Services thanked the presence of all non-profit personnel who

took the time to educate the public and advocate for their rights. Anni Chung, our President and CEO, also reminded everyone of the importance of civic participation. She then informed everyone the next free citizenship workshop is scheduled on November 25, 2019 at Chinatown YMCA. Additionally, she encouraged everyone to participate in Census 2020.
