CCHCA appreciated Anni and the Self-Help team for providing the meal services that their patients have needed, especially during the pandemic.

Since March, many of the seniors have not been able to go out and have had to stay at home for a long time. Self-Help for the Elderly has continued to provide critical services like the nutritious meals and home-delivered meals program; over the phone counseling; social services; and virtual services to care for the seniors. Furthermore, CCHCA and Self-Help have collaborated to provide home care, hospice and other essential services to the homebound seniors, ensuring they are healthy mentally and physically.

In addition, Self-Help for the Elderly collaborated with CCHCA to establish a Chinese Community Task Force on COVID-19 where community professionals and leaders gathered to discuss and disseminate the latest and reliable information about the pandemic and interpret it in a way that applied to the Chinese community.

Since June, Self-Help reopened seven Activities Centers. Currently we are offering over 6,600 nutritious meals-to-go per week for the seniors in San Francisco; we also resumed the Choosing Healthy Appetizing Meal Plan Solution for Seniors (CHAMPSS) program and home-delivered meals program.

Dignity Health St. Mary's Medical Center Awarded the Asian Health Collaborative to Address Critical Healthcare Needs in the Asian Community

The Asian Health Collaborative (AHC) is grateful for the \$40,000 Grant Award from Dignity Health St. Mary's Medical Center to address critical healthcare needs among low-income Asian seniors, youth and children in San Francisco.

AHC consists of three community-based organizations — Self Help for the Elderly, Chinatown YMCA, and the Asian Women's Resource Center / Gum Moon Asian Women's Residence, who have been working closely together to increase access to food, wellness checks via telephones, and important health information on both physical and mental health for the community.

For this Grant Award, AHC will be focused on food security and healthcare presentations. A designated Asian Health Collaborative SF YouTube Channel is created to share educational videos on wellness checks, health tips workshops and preventive programs like flu shots, COVID testing, etc.

We Have Completed 47,135 Miles to Walk, Run, Ride to the Moon

In responding to the COVID-19 "Shelter In Home & Social Distancing" orders, Self-Help for the Elderly (SHE) combined the Annual Longevity Walkathon Parade and San Mateo Center's Annual Autumn Moon Festival Celebration to Walk, Run, Ride to the Moon. The event concluded on October 1, 2020 in which Autumn Moon Festival fell on the same date on the lunar calendar. This is Self-Help for the Elderly's first virtual fitness event that combines personal fitness, charity, and community. It is vital to encourage hope and to care for our physical and mental health. In Chinese culture, the full moon is the brightest on this night and signifies completeness and family unity.

We were overwhelmed by the love and support of many benefactors, corporate friends and fitness enthusiasts. The encouraging responses exceeded our expectations. With 468 participants who chose a favorite fitness activity to support a good cause, the Walk, Run, Ride to the Moon event garnered over \$115,000 in 47 days. The donation advanced Self-Help for the Elderly's COVID-19 Emergency Meals Delivery Program and interactive online classes for seniors.

Comcast & Self-Help for the Elderly's Intergenerational Youth Leadership & Technology Program Graduation

On December 22nd, 2020, there were 17 students who graduated from the program. Comcast & Self-Help for the Elderly's Intergenerational Youth Leadership & Technology Program has been a success for over 10 years, educating young students from inner city neighborhood with the tools necessary to succeed in today's competitive environment.

Under the guidance and support from Anni Chung and the financial support of Comcast, the program was able to reach many students in the Chinatown neighborhood. The students were taught leadership skills, financial literacy and computer technology for almost a year, every Saturday morning at our 601 Jackson Street facility. Students from the program came from diverse backgrounds and of different ages. This made them very unique and different than most classes. They were led by qualified instructor, John Nguyen, who is dedicated and competent in both computer technology and financial literacy.

While the students competed against one another

in the class, they also learned to work effectively in various teams to accomplish their goals. They also participated in multiple charitable events, which Self-Help for the Elderly hosted and worked closely with the seniors through their volunteering. Most memorable events were the Cantonese Opera Event, where the students helped guide seniors to their seats, and the Longevity Walkathon, where they walked alongside with the neighborhood seniors and San Francisco mayor, London Breed.

It is the goal of the program to produce well rounded young leaders with the focus to help them break the cycle of poverty and develop compassion for the charitable work. This year's graduation ceremony will be commenced by Anni Chung, Self-Help for the Elderly's CEO & Mr. Auyoung Dillon, Comcast's Director of Government Affairs of San Francisco & Northern Peninsula. Two of the people, whom these students can look up to and emulate as concrete examples of success.

自二零零零年起,該計劃由Comcast在全國范圍內資助,名稱為「Comcast Digital Connectors」。該計劃接受了來自美國各地不同背景的貧困學生。在三藩市華埠社區, Comcast與安老自助處合作,為灣區三藩市的學生提供指導。

「Comcast Digital Connectors」計劃在二零一六年在全國范圍內結束。不過,因為安老自助處明白到該計劃對社區積極的影響,以及年輕人與老年人之間保持聯繫的重要性,因而決定繼續推行這個計劃,繼續為貧困的學生提供指導及協助;此計劃亦正式更名為《跨世代青少年領袖及科技計劃》。時至今天,它是「Comcast Digital Connectors」唯一遺留下來的計劃,每年的畢業率亦在逐步提高。

該計劃與眾不同的地方是它招募的學生是來自不同年級和背景。 這促使學生學習如何與持有不同觀點的其他人合作,解決矛盾,並傳達他們自己的觀點。 課堂於每週六上午九時,在華埠積臣街六零一號二樓的電腦實驗室舉行。 在每週的課程中,學生接受了為期十個月的領導技能,金融知識和電腦技術的培訓。 該計劃學生均由在電腦技術及金融知識等方面均具有資格和實力的講師John Nguyen指導。

當學生在計劃中互相競爭時,他們亦學習了在團隊中有效地 工作以實現共同的目標。他們參加了由安老自助處舉辦的多 個慈善活動。通過社區義工服務, 他們學習如何與長者相處 及緊密合作。在二零一九及二零二零年期間, 該計劃的學生 在安老的感恩節午餐會上提供了幫助。他們為午餐會準備了 廚房區域, 以便長者可在感恩節期間用餐。在慈善粵劇活動 期間,他們擔任義工,成為守門員和帶位員,協助長者就座 看戲。此外, 最激動人心的活動之一是「安老長壽百萬行同樂 日」, 學生們與華埠地區的鄰里長者一起散步, 並藉機會結識 了三藩市市長倫敦布里德及州參議員威善高。學生能夠參與 各種活動不僅可以促進年輕人參與志願服務的興趣, 而且還 可以增進新的友誼, 使學生有意義地與他人建立聯繫。 「感 謝這計劃,因為它讓我認識了兩位最新最好的朋友。」 該計 劃2020年的畢業生Qianen Feng笑說。
